Neither the Campsie, Strathblane, Baldernock and Kirkintilloch Agricultural Society nor the Show Committee, nor any person acting on their behalf, accept any liability or may be held responsible for any accident, damage, illness or injury to horses, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. All competitors and their horses must have their own public liability insurance cover either through a society or their own personal horse and rider equivalent policies.

All riders must wear hats conforming to the latest British Standard when mounted anywhere on the show field. All headgear must have chin strap properly fastened and securely fitted when mounted in the show field.

All horse/pony passports must be brought to show. Dogs must be kept on lead at all times. For safety reasons all horses and ponies must be kept at walk except in the competition rings or the designated warm up rings. Anyone not complying with this regulation may be asked to leave the Show field.

Mr Henry Braid, Veterinary Surgeon, will be present on the show field for the duration of the show.

Medical and First Aid cover will be in attendance for the duration of the show. Medical fees are now included in class entry fees. (Paramedics will be based at the show jumping ring)

Pre-Entries close for all classes on **THURSDAY 4<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2026**.  
Please collect numbers from the Horse Secretary's tent.

Late entries will be accepted on the day at an additional one-off charge of £10.00 per competitor.

All vehicles must be parked as directed by Stewards. Due to limited space in the horse parking area, cars without trailers are not permitted under any circumstances; they must be parked in the public car park. Ringside parking is available for disabled badge holders. Please ask in advance or in the Secretaries tent.

All sponsors are detailed on our website all year and if applicable will have a link to their website from the show website [www.campsieshow.co.uk](http://www.campsieshow.co.uk) If you are interested in becoming a sponsor or would like to donate a trophy for any area of the competition that doesn't currently have one then please contact the light horse secretary or the secretary for other aspects to the show.

Please note that where there is an age restriction for a rider the age is that on day of show, unless otherwise stated within the schedule.

The judge's decision is final in all classes.

Please ensure you take all rubbish home or use bins provided.

Please note that schedule timings are approximate except for start times of 9 am. It is therefore the responsibility of the competitor to present themselves on time for classes they have entered. It will be at the Judge's discretion if competitors can compete should they be late for a class. Please ask the steward in the ring before entering.
