HomeCraft Entry Schedule

Please note, this year in the Handcraft Tent, we have another class that helps us to help others.

This year, donations will go towards helping patients and relatives of those leaving hospital/hospices.

Donation of your entry item is entirely optional, and there is no pressure at all to donate your crafted item.

A pillowcase//pillow slip sewn in to a tote bag allows patients to leave hospital or hospice with their belongings in a dignified manner. Often people arrive at hospital in a hurry and in the clothes that they stand in. A nicer tote bag allows patients and their loved ones to leave with belongings in a cotton bag, rather than polythene bags for example.

Children's themed pillowcase bags will be donated to children's wards/CHAS.

If you are on a roll with the sewing machine, feel free to turn the whole duvet in to bags also! The more the merrier!

· No article which has already won a prize at a Show of the Society can be entered. Competitors are limited to one entry per class.

· Exhibits can be removed from 3 or 4pm. The committee cannot accept responsibility for these items.

· Prize money can be collected from the Homecraft Convenor in the tent between 1.30 and 4pm.
