EQUINE INFLUENZA ADVICE – All competitors are advised to adhere to “best practice” hygiene and bio-security measures to minimise spread of any disease and that all equine exhibits **MUST** be vaccinated against Equine Influenza prior to entry to the showground. Random passport checks will be carried out at the discretion of the Show Organisers.

QUALIFYING CLASSES – IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Class 3 BOTANICA/BHS Scotland Working Hunter Series 2019

Eligibility: Horses must be 15hh or over, 4 years old and over. Riders must be 18 years or over. **To compete at the final, either the rider or owner of the horse must be a member of the BHS. To compete at the FINAL riders must be a BHS Member and this must be registered prior to date of the final.**

Course: At least 8 and not more than 12 fences, with change of direction, must be set in a ring large enough to permit jumping fluently at a fair hunting pace. Fences should be rustic or as natural as possible, not easily dislodged, of solid appearance, well filled and with shrubs as wings. Maximum height 3’6”, (1.05m), maximum spread 3’9” (1.12m), except open ditch and water. The course **should be set at or near maximum** unless the judge considers that the ground makes un-safe. Normally at least one upright and one spread must be at maximum. The competition series is run under Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain (SHB (GB) the governing body of all hunter and sports horse classes.) It is the responsibility of organisers and competitors to be familiar with these rules; they can be found at <http://www.sporhorsegb.co.uk> **Please be aware of the rule number 48 H which states: All ridden hunters must be shod all round. No pads or surgical shoes are allowed.**

Qualifying: The first THREE qualify for the final, even if they did not jump clear. If one of the first three has already qualified, the qualifying card can be handed down to the fourth place provided the 4th placed rider jumped clear.

Final: The final is to be held at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials in August 2019.

CALEDONIAN SHOWING CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Caledonian Showing Championships are now well established in the showing calendar and will once again give 2019 competitors the opportunity to compete at a top-level Championship Final in Scotland. Evening performances loads of bling and razzmatazz... everything an end of season Championship should have!

This Show is a qualifier and every horse and pony placed 1st and 2nd in all In-hand and Ridden Showing Classes (not fun classes) and Working Hunter/Pony Classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. Qualification will be from placings; no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring and no qualification can go down the line.

Qualification is for the Horse and Pony except Adult/Young Handler Classes where the Handler qualifies. All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com where you will also find a regular updated list of qualifying shows as well as a wealth of other information.

Open to members and non-members. However, **only Members may go forward to the Championship of the day.** VHS Membership to be applied for no later than 1 week prior to this show, to avoid disappointment.

VHS Scottish Supreme (Pre-Judging) Final Qualification. Only members may qualify. Qualification is given to the highest placed VHS Member in each age category no lower than 3rd place. VHS Show registration Card is to be produced and handed to the judge in the ring as verification of the qualification. VHS Membership to be applied for no later than 1 week prior to this show, to avoid disappointment. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS 2019 Rule Book in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

Mountain and Moorland. The highest placed Member in each age category exhibiting an M & M will receive entry to the pre judging of the Mountain & Moorland Supreme Final. This may be carried down to 4th place. To be registered with a Breed Society and hold a current Breed Society passport. Show Registration Card to be signed by the judge in the ring.

New for 2019 -Young Rider and Handler Championship Qualification. A Young Rider and or Handler qualification will be awarded to the young rider/handler of the Judge's choice in each age category entitling them to enter the Young Rider/Handler Pre Qual Championship prior to the Supreme Final. This award is given at the Judge's discretion. Non-members to receive an orange card.

Mountain and Moorland – The highest placed Mountain and Moorland in each veteran class will receive entry to the pre-judging of the Mountain & Moorland Supreme Final at Ingliston. Providing they are members. This may be carried down to 4th place. To be registered with a Breed Society and hold a current Breed Society passport.

BIDWELLS RIDDEN CLYDESDALE SERIES

To be judged as a ridden hunter class. This class is a qualifier for the Bidwells Ridden Clydesdale Championship to be held at Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Sunday 25th August 2019. The first two in each class to qualify. Qualification may go down to fourth place, if horses placed 1st and 2nd have previously qualified. Registered Clydesdales and those eligible for registration may qualify and enter for the Championship.

FESTIVAL SCOTLAND 2019

This show is affiliated to the Festival Scotland 2019 Championship. Qualification cards entitle the competitor to enter all classes at both the Scotland and England Summer Championships in 2019. The top 3 not already qualified within the top 6 placings will receive a qualification card. For further information visit: www.festivalchampions.co.uk or join our Facebook page.

Scotland's Festival of Champions will be held at Morris Equestrian Centre, on the 10th and 11th of August 2019, with various classes for in hand, ridden and whp.

In memory of the late Mr David Ralston, Rosemary Brown of DRB Stud will award the highest placed pure or part bred Irish draught horse in each applicable class a special rosette. When entering any classes please state if your horse is pure bred or part bred Irish Draught.

Please note there is a change to our class entry this year with medical cover included in entry fee.

NPS Scotland Finals (Blair Castle) Rules 2019

TO BE RUN UNDER NPS SCOTLAND FINALS (BLAIR CASTLE) RULES 2019 which are on the NPS Scotland website www.npsscotland.co.uk These rules clarify areas particular to NPS Scotland. Exhibitors are deemed to be conversant with these rules.

1a Ponies may only qualify **once** for each NPS Scotland Competition Final.

1b Ponies that take a second qualifier for the same section **will be disqualified** from entering the final.

1c It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that their jockey/handler is aware of their pony's qualification status

2. All Mountain & Moorland Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective stud book. Part bred, X registered ponies, ponies in the appendices of their main stud book and Eriskay ponies are not eligible.

3. Qualification in the M. & M In Hand Section may go Champion, Reserve Champion and 1st Reserve Champion. This excludes the NPS Scotland Spring and Summer Shows where 1st and 2nd prize winners will qualify.

Qualification for M&M Novice, Open, WHP, Lead Rein, First Ridden and Riding pony/Hunter pony classes may go to no lower than 4th place.

4. A Judge is not obliged to award an NPS Scotland Finals qualification if he/she feels that the pony is not of a sufficient standard

5. Cavasson nosebands are the only nosebands permitted in flat ridden class

6. NPS Scotland Kilmannan Novice Ridden

Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided, they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year.

7. Entries will only be accepted via our on-line entry system, Entry Master

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to keep the qualification card safely as it is essential to complete your entry. Paper entries will not be accepted.

8. Closing Dates for Entries

Wednesday 31st July 2019 for all shows prior to that date. Shows from 1st to 5th August – the closing date is 8th August

Please refer to NPS Scotland website for directions on "**How to submit your entry**" on the Entry Master

9. The OWNER must be or become a member of NPS Scotland to enter the Finals.

10. All ridden ponies must be shown off the lead rein except in the specified Lead Rein Qualifier Class.

11. In Mountain and Moorland classes riders of stallions must be 12 years old or over when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B). For large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D) riders of stallions must be 14 years old or over.

12. A child must have attained their 12th birthday as of the 1st January in the current year to either strip or lunge pony at a NPS show, except for stallions where age will same as in the Rule Book to ride a stallion.

13. Handlers of stallions or colts must be 14 years old or over.

14. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull caps/riding hat that meets the current standards.

15. The Finals will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 23rd August 2019.
