TO BE RUN UNDER NPS SCOTLAND FINALS (BLAIR CASTLE) RULES 2023 which are on the NPS Scotland website www.npsscotland.co.uk These rules clarify areas particular to NPS Scotland. We also run to the Rules of the NPS and again these can be found on the NPS Scotland website. There are new rules this year so please be vigilant and read them. Exhibitors are deemed to be conversant with these rules.

NOVICE M&M RIDDEN CLASSES

NPS Scotland/Kilmannan Stud Novice Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship - The 2 highest placed ponies in classes 30 & 31, not already qualified, will qualify for the Final which will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 25th August 2023. Qualifications to go no lower than 4th place.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i. Won an open affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
- ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, BSPS Lemeiux Final or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes.
