- No article which has already won a prize at a Show of the Society can be entered. Competitors are limited to one entry per class.
- Exhibits can be removed from 4pm. The committee cannot accept responsibility for these items.
- Prize money can be collected from the Homecraft Convenor in the tent between 1.30 and 4pm.
